Access to information within the database is restricted to authorised members of the Council in order that they may perform their duties for the benefit of Society members.

The database is maintained and regularly updated to ensure the accuracy and security of data.

Members wishing to change the information held about them within the database may do so by writing to the ELRPS Membership Secretary, PO Box 629, Stalybridge, SK19 9AR.

The data held in respect of individual members will not be shared with other organisations without their specific consent.

Unless instructed otherwise, data will be held for a period of 12 months from the date of an individual's membership of the Society being terminated.

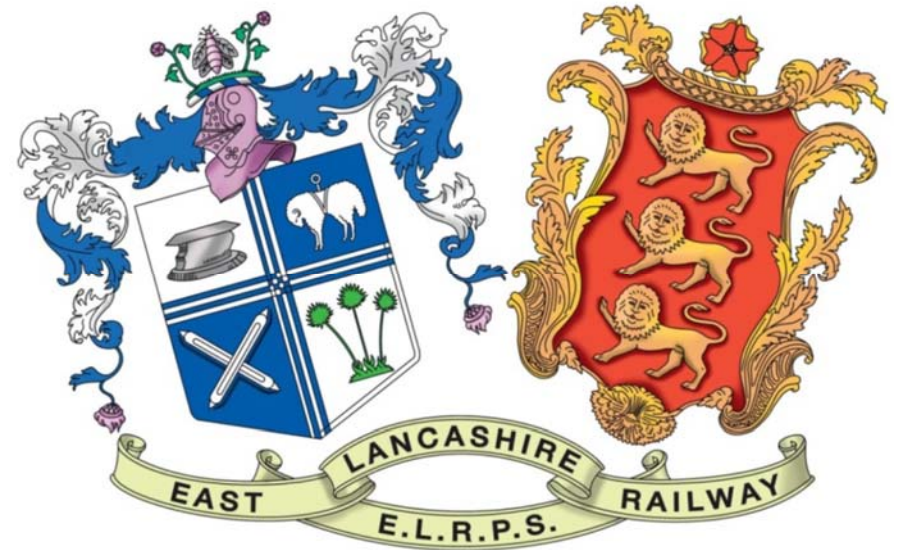
Any changes to the Data Protection Policy and this Policy Statement will be communicated to members.
