FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Please take a moment to read the below information relating to your upcoming visit to our Halloween Ghost Train.



Entrance into the Event

The event starts at the main entrance of Bury Bolton Street Station.

There will also be an accessible route marked out to Platforms 3 & 4.

Tickets will be checked on entry so please print your tickets at home or show them on your mobile device when asked to present them. You can find your e-ticket attached to your original confirmation email.



Event Timings

Please ensure you arrive at Bury Bolton Street Station in advance of the departure time printed on your e-ticket. We recommend at least 20 minutes prior to ensure you have enough time to enjoy our spooky footbridge & platform.



Car Parking

There is limited chargeable car parking in close proximity to the railway which is likely to fill to capacity. We strongly recommend using alternative car parks in Bury to help ease congestion and ensure you arrive on time.

This is an extremely busy event, so please plan ahead.

Drinks, food and snacks will be available to purchase during the event from Bury Bolton Street Station including a Halloween BBQ and Station Café, located on Platform 3 and 4, as well a food van at Bury Transport Museum for those of you that have booked onto Carn-Evil.



Carn-Evil?

Our Carn-Evil fun fair will take place at Bury Transport Museum - this is located directly opposite Bury Bolton Street Station. Simply show your ticket at the ticket booth located at Bury Transport Museum entrance to receive your wristbands.

Please note: the main route to Bury Transport Museum has steps, however please feel free to follow the marked accessible route.

Carn-Evil will be open from 16:00 and 21:00. You can enter whenever you like within these times that suit your train departure.

For example those booked on the 20:30 Halloween Train departure would need to attend the Carn-Evil **BEFORE** their train departure as it will be closed upon your return.

If you have not added Carn-Evil tickets at check out, don't worry, you can purchase these on the day from the ticket booth at the entrance to Bury Transport Museum yard priced at £10.00 per person which includes unlimited access to rides and access to Bury Transport Museum.

The Swing Boats (children up to 12)
