ENTRANCE INTO THE EVENT

The event takes place at **Bury Transport Museum**, the entrance to which is located opposite Bury Bolton Street Station, BL9 0EY.

Access is via Castle car park via the steps at the back.

There will also be an accessible route marked out to **Bury Transport Museum** on the main road which avoids the main steps.

Tickets will be checked upon entry, so please print your tickets at home or show them on your mobile device when asked to present them. You can find your e-ticket attached to your original confirmation email.

EVENT TIMINGS

Please ensure you arrive at **Bury Transport Museum** at your pre-booked time slot (printed on your e-ticket).

Your entry time stated is to access Bury Transport Museum where you will meet Peter Rabbit. All activities in the museum yard and your train journey are to be enjoyed before or after meeting Peter Rabbit at your pre-booked time.

Should you miss your Peter Rabbit meet time, we will be unable to move you to the next session as we are fully booked.

TRAIN RIDE

A complimentary train ride on East Lancashire Railway is included in your Peter Rabbit Fun Day ticket.

You can travel on any time train that suits you throughout the day to any and all stations, either before or after your Peter Rabbit experience. Your ticket is valid for unlimited return journeys all day.

To advise our peak time trains depart from Bury at 11:31 and 14:12. These trains do get exceptionally busy, and seating may be limited.

ACCESSIBLE ROUTE

There will be an accessible route marked out to **Bury Transport Museum** which avoids the main steps. Head towards Bury Transport Museum entrance opposite Bury Bolton Street station and you will pick up the accessible route marked out by floor stickers and directional signage around the area.

PUSH CHAIRS

Space for push chairs is limited so please only bring if absolutely necessary.

We have an accessible route marked out for step-free access to Bury Transport Museum - please follow floor stickers and signage.

CAR PARKING

Limited chargeable parking is available at Bolton Street Station (BL9 0EY). There are also additional car parks available in the centre of Bury. [CLICK HERE TO VIEW LIST OF CAR PARKS](#)
